NOTE: The number denotes the division, and the letters following indicate the colors of the flowers. The letter before the hyphen is the petal color, and those following are for the cup:

White, Yellow, Green, Orange, Red, and Pink.

Divisions 1, 2, 3, 4, and 11 are generally larger, taller flowers with one to a stem. Divisions 5, 7, and 8 have smaller flowers with generally more than one to a stem. Division 6 and 9 have smaller flowers with one to a stem. Stem length varies in these upper divisions, with divisions 5, 6, and 7 usually having shorter stems.
